

Zanda McDonald Award

Terms and Conditions

- 1. Applicants must answer all questions in the application form.
- 2. Answers to each question must be true and correct.
- 3. Shortlisted Applicants will be required to feature in marketing and promotional material.
- 4. Shortlisted Applicants consent to having their names and photographs published.
- 5. Applicants may be required to speak to the media.
- 6. Applicants may not contact the judges directly once their application has been submitted.
- 7. Applicants accept that the judges' decision is final and no negotiation will be entered into.
- 8. The prize package is non-transferable either to another person or to a cash equivalent.
- 9. The Award reserves the right to change components of the prize package at its discretion. However, any changes to the prize will be replaced with another prize of equal or greater value.
- 10. Applicants must be aged between 21 35 years as at 31 August 2024, and working in the agriculture sectors in either Australia or New Zealand.
- 11. Applicants must have an current passport and be eligible to travel overseas
- 12. Applicants must be a resident of either Australia or New Zealand and must not be related to any person involved as an Award Judge or Director.
- 13. The prize package is valid for 12 months unless otherwise specified.
- 14. The successful applicant will be required to undertake Award Ambassador duties.
- 15. Award finalists are each responsible for the content they publish, or have published, on social media and should use good judgment in relation to their profiles being associated with the Zanda McDonald Award. Comments, expressions, and other postings on social media must be honest and respectful of others.
- 16. The prize package includes education or training up to the value of \$10,000 AU: The aim is to provide the Award recipient with further education that is in line with their future development and personal growth. The education and/or training package is not restricted to a set list of options but is subject to mutual agreement by the Award recipient and award board (and subject to acceptance into the desired training/course). Up to \$10,000 AU is available to put towards these costs, including all travel and accommodation expenses. Any costs exceeding \$10,000 will be at the Award recipient's own expense.
